OAKWING GOLF CLUB

Heritage Park serves as a proud reminder of the colorful and successful history of England Air Force Base and the 23rd fighter wing. The famous Flying Tigers are yet another chapter in central Louisiana's long history of support of our armed forces and our nation.

England Airpark traces its beginnings back to 1939 when it served as an emergency airstrip for Esler Field Airport. However, as the possibility of war in Europe increased, The Army Air Corps leased the facility naming it Alexandria Army Air Force Base. Until 1945, the facility was used as a B-17 bomber combat training school, training an average of 45 crews per month. After the cessation of hostilities in Europe in 1945, the Base was used to train B-29 Crews for duty in the Pacific Theater. In 1946, as the war ended with Japan, the base was placed on a standby status eventually being turned back over to the city of Alexandria for use as a municipal airport. With the outbreak of hostilities in Korea, the base was again reactivated as Alexandria Air Force Base in 1950. That same year it was assigned to Tactical Air Command. In June 1955, the base was officially named England Air Force Base in honor Lt. Col. John B. England who had been commander of the 389th Bomber Squadron at the base. The facility was once again closed by the Department of Defense on December 15th, 1992, and began its transition to civilian reuse as England Airpark and Community.

As fate would have it Robert's journey to become a PGA Professional began with the urging and support of a good friend.

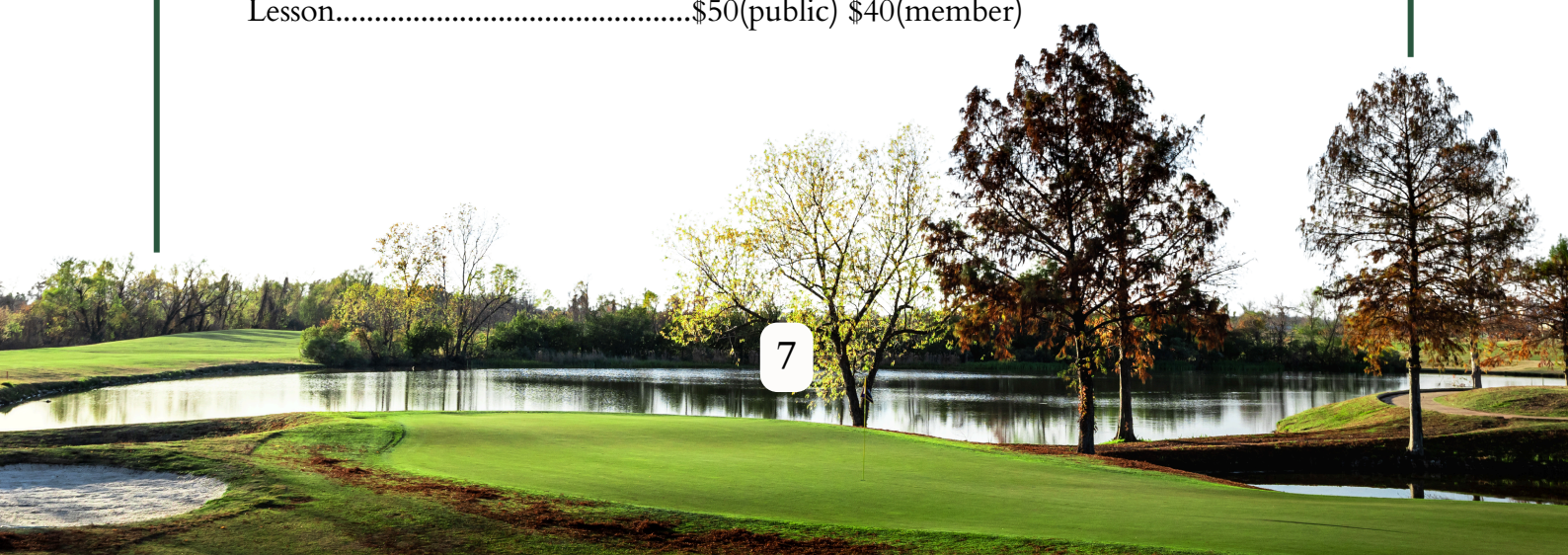

FEES & CHARGES

As we look ahead to the 2025 season, I would like to inform you of a few important updates regarding membership dues and guest policies at OakWing Golf Club.

Firstly, there will be a small increase in dues for the upcoming year. Dues increases will not come into effect until April 2025. These increases are listed on the following page. This is a common practice within the industry, and the goal is to keep our club on a sustainable path. We are taking this step to avoid the significant dues increases that many of you experienced in the 2024 season. We understand that any increase can be a concern, but we remain committed to providing you with the highest level of service and maintaining the exceptional conditions you've come to expect at OakWing.

Secondly, due to consistent abuse of the previous policy, OakWing will no longer offer a "Guest of Member" rate starting January 1, 2025. We understand this change may be disappointing to some, particularly those who have utilized the guest rate as it was intended, and we sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. However, in order to ensure fairness to all members and to better manage guest access, we feel this adjustment is necessary.

Thank you for your understanding and continued support as we strive to make OakWing Golf Club an even better place for all of our members.

CLUB POLICIES

Practice Range

Practice balls are available for all members. Please practice from designated areas as this will assist in the perpetuation of a quality tee area. Practice balls are for use on the practice facilities and should not be used on the golf course for any reason. Violation of this policy will result in fines or suspension.

Tipping Policy

We strive to provide the finest service possible to all members and their guests. OakWing allows tipping in all departments.

Pace of Play/Size of Groups

As OakWing continues to grow as a Golf club, pace of play and the size of groups on the golf course will continue to be a subject of discussion.

Cell Phones

As a courtesy to those around you, we ask that your cell phone is on silent or vibrate and that cell phone use does not affect the pace of play.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted within 25 feet of building entries and exits. We are in a high-fire-danger area and request that no tobacco products be disposed of on or near the golf courses.

Lightning

When lightning is in sight, please take serious heed and seek shelter. Players assume all risks when playing when lightning is present.

Private Property

Respect homeowners' private property. Please do not enter private property, play as a lost ball.

Music

Music is allowed on the course. Our only request is that you please keep your music levels so that only you and your foursome can hear the music and it does not disturb your fellow golfers.

COURSE ATTIRE

Appropriate golf attire is required for all players on the golf course and golf course practice facilities. Members and designees are expected to ensure that immediate family members and guests adhere to such rules.

Gentlemen

Shirts with collars, golf shirts, slacks and golf shorts up to four inches above the knee are considered appropriate attire.

Long sleeve sun shirts have been approved for members in order to assist with sun protection.

Tank tops, tee shirts, fishnet tops, cut-offs, jams, sweatpants, jeans, cargo pants, swimming attire, gym shorts, tennis shorts or other athletic shorts more than four inches above the knee are not permitted.

Ladies

Dresses, skirts, slacks and golf shorts up to four inches above the knee and golf shirts are considered appropriate attire.

Halter tops, tank tops, tee shirts, fishnet tops, cut-offs, sweatpants, jeans, cargo pants, swimming attire, short shorts, tennis skirts or tennis shirts are not permitted.

Shoes

Spikeless golf shoes are recommended on the golf facilities. Shoes other than spikeless golf shoes must be approved by the Golf Shop.
